- ASSISTANCE TO CLUBS AND FUNDING FOR STUDENT EVENTS

- A SILVER LINING ON A DARK CLOUD - WHAT ABOUT THE REMAINING \$1,000?
  - Outside Donations
  - Administration
  - Unreliable source of funding
  - Varies year-to-year

- THE 3% - Mark
  - Increases by 3% every 3 years
  - UCSD School of Medicine has an annual increase similar to that of SSPPS
  - We are consistent with SOM for the increase per three year cycle because of the similar lab fees that we incur (i.e. cadavers, histology, etc)
  - The increase is also coordinated with UCSF
  - They coordinate with UCSF because they are the only other University of California pharmacy school.
- WHAT DO THE INCREASED FEES PAY FOR?
  - Part of Fees
    - IPPE/APPE Establishment
    - Part of it goes back as need-based scholarships to maintain a high caliber of students
    - New computers in all the lecture rooms
    - Automated podcasting system in 1120 (P3's)
    - Faculty salaries

  - Maintenance
    - This comes from the state, but can be fixed if you need it to be. Please direct all complaints in this area to your Class President or myself.
