- Create a draft course syllabus including a detailed description of lecture topics
- Email the two (2) completed documents above to the Curriculum Director, Shelly Janger, sjanger@health.ucsd.edu
- Proposal will be added to a future CEP meeting agenda at which the proposed course chair will attend for review and discussion. CEP may request and/or suggest revisions to the proposed course. Once proposal is finalized, CEP will vote to approve course.
- If approved, the Curriculum Director will complete and submit the UC San Diego Request for Course Approval form to the Registrar for review and approval.
- Once approved, the Curriculum Director will notify all appropriate parties and the course may be offered to students.
