UC San Diego Skaggs School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences Voluntary Faculty Appointment Application Process and Benefits

Pharmacists, residents and other health care professionals (HCPs) who provide significant preceptorship or teaching to our students are eligible to apply for a voluntary faculty appointment at the SSPPS. Submitted initial applications and subsequent renewals are reviewed by the Non Salary/Volunteer (NS/Vol) Faculty Committee and Human Resources (HR) staff by internal review criteria to ensure you meet qualification requirements for appointments. Benefits of Obtaining an Affiliate or NS/Vol Faculty Appointment with the UC San Diego Skaggs School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences

1. Proxy access to [UC San Diego Library](#) resources and physical use of library services.

 - ii. Pharmacy Librarian, Penny Coppernoll-Blach (pblach@ucsd.edu)
2. Opportunity to request and apply for professional meeting reimbursement. See preceptor Registration Fees guidelines via the link above.
3. Placed on voluntary faculty listserv
 - i. Attend preceptor development workshops hosted by the SSPPS and partners, and receive CAPE continuing education credits if applicable
 - ii. View opportunities to participate in and precept students at community health fairs and other educational events
 - iii. Receive our quarterly SSPPS Preceptor Newsletter and general SSPPS Newsletter
4. Eligible to be awarded one of several annual Preceptor Excellence Awards

Initial three year appointment, with renewals every five years.</p> <p>iii. Persons with expiring appointments will be notified of expiration and need for renewal in advance.</p> <p>iv. Renewal files are reviewed by the NS/Vol Faculty Committee and HR staff.</p> <p>v. An Affiliate appointment is simplest and fastest.</p>	<p>i. Notification of appointment <u>within four to six months</u> of submission. ii. HR staff will request additional paperwork for review packet</p> <p>iii. Initial three year appointment, with renewals every five years.</p> <p>iv. Persons with expiring appointments will be notified of expiration and need for renewal in advance.</p> <p>v. Renewals require submission of;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Evidence of strong teaching evaluations from SSPPS students, b. Evidence of scholarly activity, c. Biobibliography completed in the format required by UC San Diego. <p>vi. Renewal files are reviewed by the NS/Vol Faculty Committee and HR staff.</p> <p>vii. Promotions in academic titles require evidence of recent scholarly activity, and regular service to the SSPPS, and strong teaching evaluations.</p>
