# **Requesting Accommodations**

#### STEP 1: Schedule an Intake Appointment

The Office for Students with Disabilities is operating remotely during regularly scheduled university business hours.

If you would like to schedule an appointment, please leave a message at (858) 534-4382 or email us at <u>osd@ucsd.edu</u> and provide us with the following information.

If you are emailing, we suggest you copy and paste items #1 - #7 into the body of your email and then provide us with the information. This will expedite your request.

- 1. Your first and last name
- 2. Your PID if you have one
- 3. Your telephone number
- 4. Your UCSD email address
- 5. The reason you are requesting an appointment
- 6. At least 3 days/times you are available between 8 a.m. 4 p.m. Monday Friday for an appointment
- 7. Whether you prefer a Zoom or phone appointment, or first available

We will respond to you within 24 university business hours at either your UCSD email address or from a blocked phone number, so please pick up the call. The more information you can provide us initially, the faster we will be able to schedule your appointment.
